Troubleshooting Readiness Display	
CHARGE-PAK™ charger and electrode pads need to be replaced OR CHARGE-PAK charger is not installed	Notify: Use AED if needed.
Service needed	Immediately notify: Attempt to use AED in an emergency. If AED is inoperable, retrieve another AED if possible and continue CPR until EMS arrives.
Internal battery not fully charged	Verify CHARGE-PAK charger is installed. If missing notify: If CHARGE-PAK charger installed use unit if needed.
